SUGGESTED CAR POOL FEES FOR THE OVERNIGHT TRIPS

These suggested car pool fees are based on 5 cents per mile and 2 or more passengers. They represent a reasonable cost of providing a vehicle to the various ski resorts beyond merely gas usage. The fees include round trip to the resort and intermittent trips as needed to the base area. Final pricing is up to the discretion of the driver, so make sure you have an understanding with the driver before you leave. If there is only one passenger, the passenger should consider paying for all the gas. Additionally, all occupants need to share equally when there are parking fees and if there are additional side trips passengers should share in the associated gas costs.

GENERAL TRIP POLICIES

Though the club doesn't expect to make money on trips, it does expect each trip to cover its costs. With that in mind, please be aware of the following policies:

- The deposit guarantees your spot on the trip. Deposits in general are non-refundable.
- If something prevents you from going and a replacement can be found, the replacement person can reimburse you.
- Notify the leader promptly if you have to cancel, even if you have only paid the deposit and full payment isn't yet due.
- Balances must be paid by the due date. If a balance isn't paid by the due date someone from the wait list will take your place.
- Write a separate check to Flatirons Ski Club for each trip, and write the name of the trip in the memo line.
- Please promptly communicate any issues directly to the trip leader.








WINTER Skiing in CRESTED BUTTE

If you are looking to cross country ski this winter, Crested Butte is the place for you. Crested Butte is a cross country skier's dream, with miles of



The trip cost includes an ample continental breakfast with homemade breakfast breads, fruit, yogurt, juices, oatmeal each morning. Lunches and dinners are on your own. There are no cross-country trail passes or downhill lift tickets included as part of the trip. The Epic Pass now includes Mount Crested Butte this year. If you do not have that pass, you can still come - we anticipate the availability of several discounted lift ticket offers that were offered last year, so you will not have to pay the full ticket window price, if you don't have the Epic. Your \$50 deposit per person (non-refundable) is due now – you can bring it to the Nov meeting or mail it. Total trip cost is \$305. Final payment of \$255.00 is due on December 6th - either at the Dec meeting or by mail. Both deposit and final payment checks must be made out to the Flatirons Ski Club. **Please call or e-mail trip leaders Linda or Chris with questions.**
